V117 To discuss the purchase of a Vehicle Activated Sign

The decision was made at the last meeting to purchase the VAS from Swarco at a cost of £3,255.36 + vat inc a 5-year warranty, bluetooth data capture, post mains connection, installation & training

The Insurers have advised that the cost to add the sign to the insurance is nil up to renewal on 1st June 2020 and NYCC have advised planning permission is not required

Selby District Council has confirmed that the Parish Council can purchase the VAS and claim the money back from CIL when the next statement is received in April

Councillors discussed the Installation Agreement received from NYCC

Quotes have been received for the repairs to the Village Hall and Westfield play equipment from Hags, Streetscape Products and Teamsportplay following receipt of the recent Rospa report

Hags - £3038.08 + vat (excluding trim trail)

Quotes have been received from Lightmain to repair the Mugas and the Skateboard Ramp:

Job 1 – Goal Repairs

To supply 2 Engineers + Scaffold + Fixings to replace any missing fixings and fully tighten all others on both goal ends on both sites. To fill the small hole in the Skatelite sheet

Total Price = £375 + Vat

Job 2 – Skatelite Replacement

To supply 2 Engineers + 1 sheet of Tan Skatelite to replace the sheet with a hole in it

Total Price = £475 + Vat

To approve the quote from Lightmain for Job 1, Goal Repairs, at a cost of £375 + vat

To approve the quote from Streetscape of £1480 + vat

V120 To discuss the quote to upgrade the 13 streetlights on Selby Road to LED lanterns

Following receipt of their quote, NYCC have advised that their quote of £3685 + vat includes the supply and fitting of a double pole fused isolator (DPI) to each column where necessary and a re-wire of the column. This is an electrical safety device that is installed in the base of the column between the NPG cut out and the wiring to the lantern. If the lantern becomes faulty, it will cause the DPI to trip out, rather than the fuse in the NPG board cut out.

This is now NYCC standard practice when they replace lanterns on columns. When they install new columns, they install the DPI as part of the column.

A quote has also been received from Acorn Lighting of £212 + vat per 30w lantern each

Resolved

To approve the quote for £3685 + vat from NYCC but to ask how long the quote is valid for as the next CIL statement isn't due until April

V121 To discuss the request for a planter on the grass verge near Stuart Grove

This was requested by a resident because the bollards on this patch of grass have been knocked down by vehicles and the area is being churned up by vehicles from the new development

The Clerk has contacted NYCC who have advised that they are aware that Selby District Council Planning Enforcement Officers are currently dealing with this and they will re assess the requirement of the verge markers to see if they are still necessary.
